

File Guide

/configuration.php	File that defines all constants, table names, payment gateway urls etc.
/modules/index.php	Front-end controller file.
/modules/adminindex.php	Admin controller file.
/admin/messages.php	Retains all the messages that are displayed in the admin area.
/css/	All the CSS files for the site.
/ecom/messages.php	Common messages for the whole site.
/ecom/messages/	This folder contains the messages corresponding to the module name. Admin message files have been prefixed by "admin_".
/FCKeditor/	WYSWYG editor.
/froogle/	All the Froogle files will be uploaded to this folder. When the admin clicks the manual upload link it will create a text file in this folder. This folder must have 777 rights.
/graphics/	All the graphics used in the site are in this folder. This folder has further subsections like admin, site or any CSS related graphics. Note: If you are copying any CSS graphics in this folder than the folder name must be the same as your CSS file eg. if you are changing the CSS file jewellery.css then the graphics sub folder name should be jewellery.
/images/	This folder also has sub-folders which hold all site images uploaded via the admin. This folder must also have 777 rights.
installs/	installation related files.
jscript/	All the javascript related files are in this folder. validations.js is called into each template file.
libs/	All the library and utility files are in this folder.
modules/	This is the key folder for the site. The site has been divided into modules. Each module contains two folders admin and main. Admin controller and display files are in admin folder. Frontend controller and display files are in main folder.
modules/ecom/templates/main/	(content department product) Templates that will appear in the dropdown when creating products, departments or content pages.
scheduler/	The Froogle scheduled file is saved into this folder or any other scheduled file that may be required in the future.
UserFiles/	FCKeditor related images/docs will be saved in this folder.
